Introduction

Shrewsbury International School Hong Kong highlights 'commitment and aspiration' within Guiding Statements that also describe a 'student centred' and 'holistic' approach, designed to support 'personal growth, purpose and high standards of achievement'.

School Uniform

The compulsory application of a traditional school uniform is part of a coordinated effort to instil pride through common association, whilst driving aspiration among our student population. Students are expected to wear their uniform neatly and to keep up a good standard of personal appearance at all times.

- 1. In Early Years (Nursery and Reception), students are required to wear:
 - Shrewsbury EY sports shirt in blue
 - Shrewsbury EY school shorts or jogging bottoms
 - Plain white socks
 - Plain white trainers with non-marking soles

- 2. In Key Stage 1 (Y1 and Y2), students are required to wear:
 - Shrewsbury polo shirt
 - School trousers, shorts or skort a plain black leather belt may also be worn
 - Plain white socks
 - Plain white trainers with non-marking soles

For Physical Education lessons, students are required to wear:

- Shrewsbury Physical Education shirt
- Shrewsbury Physical Education shorts or jogging bottoms
- Plain white socks
- Plain white trainers with non-marking soles
- 3. In Key Stage 2 (Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6), students are required to wear:
 - School trousers, shorts or skort a plain black leather belt may also be worn
 - Shrewsbury school shirt, tucked in
 - Blue school tie (Y3 and Y4) Red school tie (Y5 and Y6)
 - Grey ankle-length socks
 - Black leather shoes
 - Blazers are to be worn on all formal occasions, including Friday Assembly

For Physical Education lessons, students are required to wear:

- Shrewsbury Physical Education shirt
- Shrewsbury Physical Education shorts or jogging bottoms
- Plain white socks
- Plain white trainers with non-marking soles

In order to correctly identify misplaced items, parents should label all items of clothing with the student's first and last name.

Hats:

Shrewsbury school hats are required for all students, every day, to ensure compliance with the Sunsmart Policy (E12).

Bags:

Shrewsbury backpacks or sports bags should be used by students. Students in Early Years classes are also required to use Shrewsbury book bags. House Shirts:

Primary students are required to wear a House Shirt for demarcated events and celebration days.

Cold Weather:

Shrewsbury school jumpers and fleeces may be worn by students if they feel cold. They may also wear plain white long-sleeved shirts and white or navy blue leggings or tights underneath school uniform.

Personal Presentation

Hair:

Hair should be neatly presented and tied up if longer than shoulder length.

Make-up:

Students should not wear make-up (including nail polish) to school.

Jewellery:

Students may wear a single, studded earring in each ear lobe at the discretion of their parents. They may also choose to wear a watch.

Other personal items:

Personal items brought to school should be suitably stored within cubby-holes for the duration of the school day - misuse may lead to confiscation. We strongly discourage students from bringing valuable, precious or sentimental items into school. The School cannot be held responsible for any loss.

Representing The School

Students will not be allowed to represent the school in games, or to take part in school visits, unless they are wearing school uniform unless explicitly stipulated or otherwise authorised.

Water bottles

Students should bring a personal water bottle to school every day. To avoid the spread of germs, they should not contain a spray function.

Water bottles must be clearly labelled with a student's first and last name.

Traditional Dress and Jewellery

The Principal will support the wearing of traditional dress, including items of jewellery, following consultation with parents.

Lost Property

A lost property box is situated on every floor. Unnamed items are delivered to a central collection point in the Reception on the Ground Floor. Lost property is recycled at the end of each school term. It is the students' and parents' responsibility to retrieve their items from lost property in good time.
